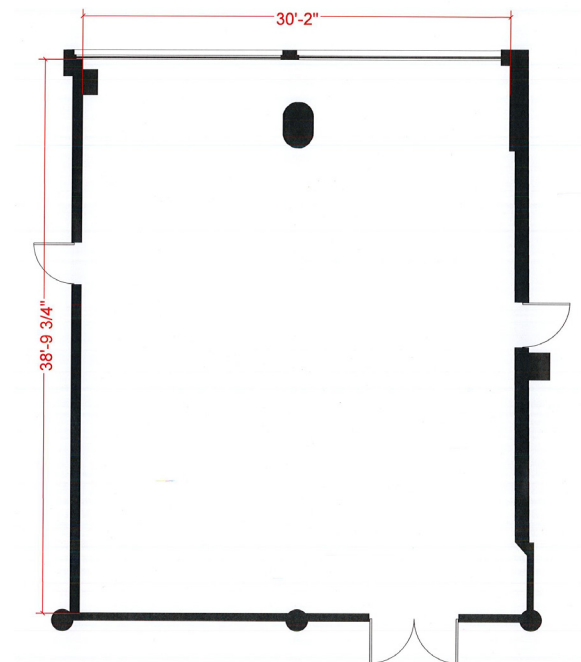
Bottleworks Hotel is committed to honoring the past, while at the same time, ushering in a new era for the historic property in **a bold and unexpected way.**

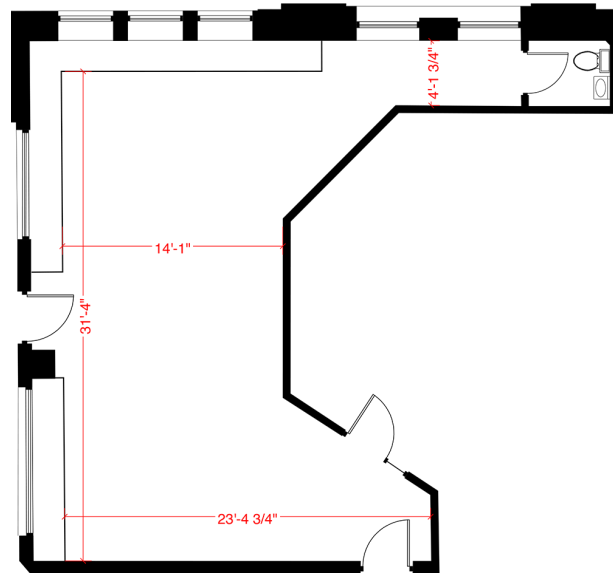

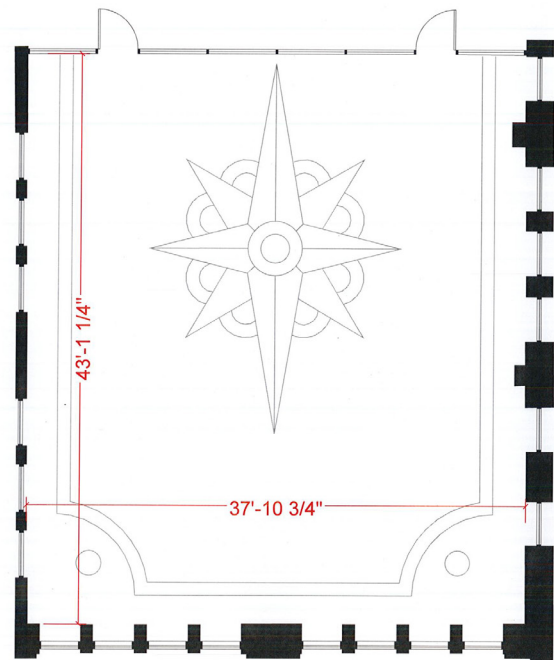
## STAR ROOM

1,634 SQ FT • 38' X 43'

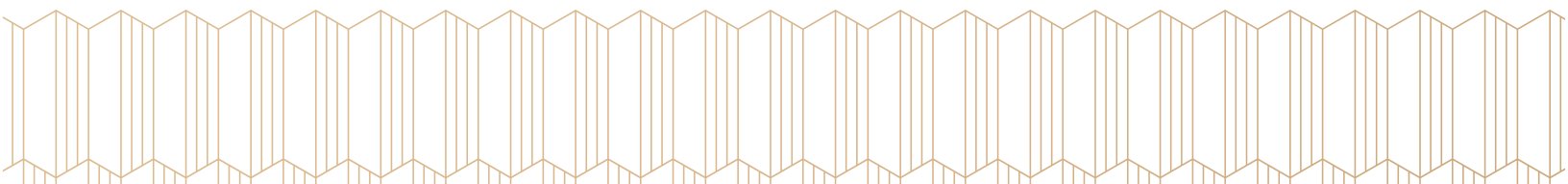
The Star Room is Bottleworks Hotel's largest event and banquet space.

**Built for the modern traveler,** the 139-key boutique Bottleworks Hotel will occupy the top two floors of the historic bottling works administration building.



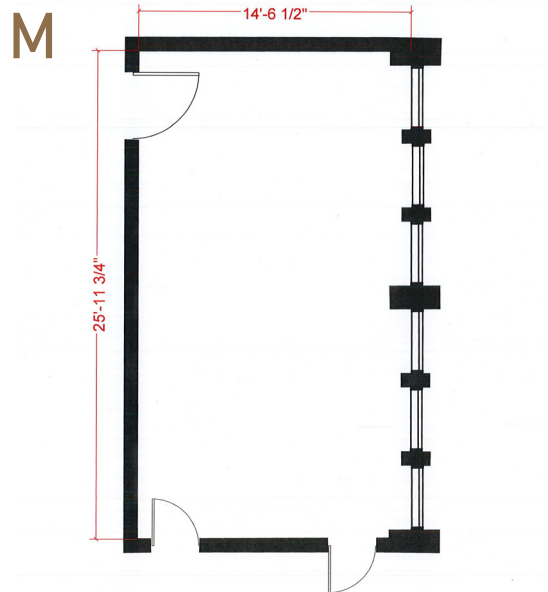

**6,972 SQ FT • 42' X 166'**

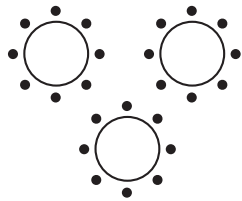
